4. Steps taken by the Institute/Department/College to improve the quality of Education with regard to following quality parameters of NAAC for the College:

- i. **Curricular Aspects:** The College is imparting UG level courses both in Humanities (Arts) and Commerce stream. In the Humanities (Arts) stream the college is presently running Bachelor level courses in eight (8) subjects, viz., English, Hindi, Economics, History, Mathematics, Sociology, Music (Instrumental) and Political Science.
- ii. **Teaching-Learning & Evaluation:** The students of the college are imparted education through Blended Learning by Lecture Method, PPT in classrooms and interaction is also maintained through different online platforms for the better understanding and preparation of the students. The subject related notes are also provided to the students and Tutorials, Class presentations, Quizzes, projects, Assignment Work is also carried on during the Academic Session. In addition to it Class Tests, House Tests and Oral Tests are also conducted to strengthen the academic excellence of the students. Annual Examinations are also conducted for the students as per the schedule and guidelines of the HPU towards the end of each Year.

iii. Research, Consultancy & Extension:

- a) The college has constituted IQAC (as per the NAAC requirement) to promote research and related activities. The college is preparing itself to apply for the NAAC Accreditation in near future.
- b) The College Teaching staff is actively engaged in research related activities. During this session the faculty member in addition to publishing research papers in their respective disciplines. Two Assistant Professor namely Dr. Naresh Kumar and Dr. Milanpreet completed their Ph.D Degree recently and now the college has 6 faculty members who have doctorate degrees including the Principal of the College.
- c) Infrastructure and Learning Resources: The College is putting constant efforts to improve college Infrastructures gradually with its limited funds. During this session 2023-24 five computers with printers were purchased for the use of office staff. To secure the campus and to make it safe for the students cameras were installed to keep round the clock vigilance at different important locations and a gate has been constructed to prevent the entry of outsiders in the college. The college has already placed requisition for more computers and special software for the college library. 1000 more books were added to the college library donated by the State Library at Shimla, this year. Students are also provided education learning erecourses. The College also has ICT enabled virtual classroom/ conference room for Smart Classroom Teaching.

- d) Student Support and Progression: The College is putting its best efforts through CCC (Career Counseling & Placement Cell) to provide guidance & motivation to the students by inviting various field experts from time to time. The College is running several Clubs/Societies with the assistance of students. The institution has NSS, NCC, Road Safety Club, Red Ribbon Club, Eco- Club, Sports-Club, Tours & Trekking Club, Drug Abuse Club etc. for the all-around development of the students. All the meritorious & eligible students were provided necessary help and guidance regarding various meritorious scholarships schemes of state and central government. This session, a total of five students have applied for scholarships under different schemes, including Post-Matric, Kalpana Chawla Scheme, Minority Scholarship Scheme, and Ambedkar Scholarship Schemes.
- e) Governance and Leadership: The quality of governance and leadership is inculcated among the students by nominating the students as the office -bearers and Nominated Representatives of various classes and different Clubs (the CSCA Body) as per the guidelines of H.P. University and by handing over them the charge of various events/activities throughout the year. The college also convenes meetings from time to time with these office bearers to take their suggestions for the betterment of college and to discuss the issues related to the student's welfare. Various scholarship schemes operated by the central and state governments are benefiting students..

iii) Innovative Practices:

- a) The students of the college are being made e-literate, tech-equipped and imparted with practical tutorials on creating e-notes (assignments) and are being trained to operate Computers in addition to regular class-room teaching.
- b) The college website has been renewed to upgrade the college to a high-tech level, through which students can access complete information related to the college.
- c) For the convenience of students this session, 70 new desks have been procured.
- d) New library tables and chairs have been purchased for the college library, along with approximately 450 new books related to various subjects.
- e) To ensure the security of the college campus and the safety of students, CCTV cameras have been installed.
- f) Plantation drives were held by Eco Club, NSS, NCC to make the College campus green.

Since the building of Government Degree College Diggal (Solan) still lacks adequate infrastructure like proper Examination Hall, Library, ICT enabled Computer Lab, Conference Hall & Playground etc. and is nearly in its initial stage of development, the college administration and staff is committed to its betterment and expects to have higher grades of NAAC accreditation in the future.
